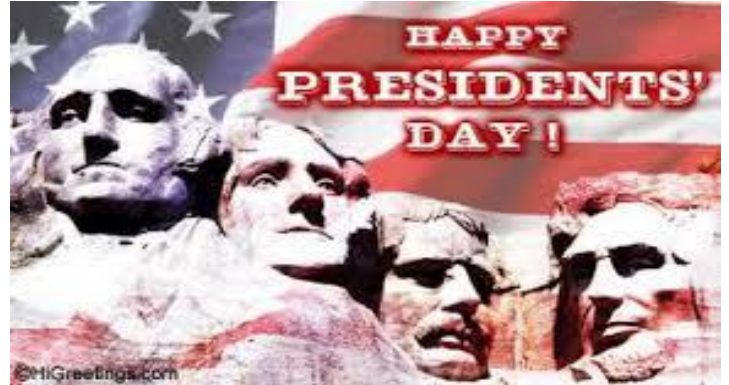
Sunshine Committee:

RECIPE
