With summer here zucchini are plentiful. Here is a great Zucchini Cake recipe to try!

Zucchini Cake

2.5 cups all purpose flour
2 cups sugar
1.5 teaspoons ground cinnamon
1 teaspoon salt
½ teaspoon baking powder
½ teaspoon baking soda
1 cup vegetable oil
4 eggs
2 cups shredded zucchini
½ cup chopped walnuts (optional)

Frosting:
½ package cream cheese softened
¼ cup butter softened
1 tablespoon milk
1 teaspoon vanilla
2 cups confections sugar

In a mixing bowl combine the flour, sugar, cinnamon, salt, baking powder, and baking soda. In a separate bowl combine the oil and eggs. Add the oil and egg mixture to the dry ingredients and mix well. Add zucchini and walnuts (if desired) to mixture. Pour into greased 13X9 pan. Cook in oven at 350 degrees for 35-40 minutes. For frosting, in a bowl mix together cream cheese, butter, milk and vanilla until smooth. Add the confectioners sugar to mixture. Spread onto cooled cake. Sprinkle top with additional chopped walnuts if desired.
